## **HOUSE COMMITTEE ACTION ON ALL APPROPRIATION BILLS TO BE COMPLETED BY JUNE 10**

<sup>§ 307</sup> **SEC. 307.**<sup>385</sup> On or before June 10 of each year, the Committee on Appropriations of the House of Representatives shall report annual appropriation bills<sup>386</sup> providing new budget authority<sup>387</sup> under the jurisdiction of all of its subcommittees for the fiscal year which begins on October 1 of that year.
