(2) It shall not be in order<sup>473</sup> in the Senate to consider any amendment<sup>474</sup> to a reconciliation bill or reconciliation resolution<sup>475</sup> if such amendment would have the effect of decreasing any specific budget outlay<sup>476</sup> reductions below the level of such outlay reductions provided (for the fiscal years covered) in the reconciliation instructions which relate to such bill or resolution set forth in a resolution providing for reconciliation, or would have the effect of reducing Federal revenue increases below the level of such revenue increases provided (for such fiscal years) in such instructions relating to such bill

below the level of such revenue increases provided (for such fiscal years) in such instructions relating to such bill or resolution, unless such amendment makes a reduction in other specific budget outlays, an increase in other specific Federal revenues, or a combination thereof (for such fiscal years) at least equivalent<sup>477</sup> to any increase in outlays or decrease in revenues provided by such amendment, except that a motion to strike a provision shall always be in order.

§ 310(d)(3)

(3) Paragraphs (1)<sup>478</sup> and (2)<sup>479</sup> shall not apply if
