(B) whether or not (or to what extent), in his judgment, such proposed deferral is in accordance with existing statutory authority.

§ 1014(c)

(c) TRANSMISSION OF SUPPLEMENTARY MESSAGES. — If any information contained in a special message transmitted under section 1012^{1047} or 1013^{1048} is subsequently revised, the President shall transmit to both Houses of Congress and the Comptroller General a supplementary message stating and explaining such revision. Any such supplementary message shall be delivered, referred, and printed as provided in subsection (a). The Comptroller General shall promptly notify the House of Representatives and the Senate of any changes in
