the information submitted by him under subsection (b)<sup>1050</sup> which may be necessitated by such revision.

- (d) PRINTING IN FEDERAL REGISTER. Any special message transmitted under section 1012<sup>1051</sup> or 1013, <sup>1052</sup> and any supplementary message transmitted under subsection (c), <sup>1053</sup> shall be printed in the first issue of the Feral Register published after such transmittal.
- (e) CUMULATIVE REPORTS OF PROPOSED RESCISSIONS, RESERVATIONS, AND DEFERRALS OF BUDGET AUTHORITY. —
- (1) The President shall submit a report to the House of Representatives and the Senate not later than the 10th day of each month during a fiscal year, listing all budget authority 1054 for that fiscal year with respect to which, as of the first day of such month —
- (A) he has transmitted a special message under section  $1012^{1055}$  with respect to a proposed rescission or a reservation; and
- (B) he has transmitted a special message under section 1013<sup>1056</sup> proposing a deferral.<sup>1057</sup>
