§ 2(b)(2) (2) The Director's<sup>1866</sup> projections shall be based on legislation enacted as of 5 days before the report is submitted under paragraph (1). To the extent feasible, the Director shall use the same economic and technical assumptions used in preparing the concurrent resolution on the budget for fiscal year 1994 (H.Con.Res. 64).<sup>1867</sup>

§ 2(c) (c) *Adjustments.* Direct spending targets shall be subsequently adjusted by the Director<sup>1868</sup> under Section 6.<sup>1869</sup>

§ 3 **Sec. 3. Annual Review of Direct Spending and Receipts by President.** As part of each budget submitted under section 1105(a) of title 31, United States Code,<sup>1870</sup> the Director<sup>1871</sup> shall provide an annual review of direct spending<sup>1872</sup> and receipts, which shall include
